The Board of Directors of Hunter Ranch Improvement District No. 1 of Denton County, Texas will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, February 24, 2026, at 12:00 p.m., at City of Denton Development Services Center, 401 N. Elm Street, Training Room 1, Denton, Texas**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comment(s) – In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Directors are prohibited from acting on or discussing any items brought before them at this time. Citizen’s comments will be limited to 3 minutes. Comments about any of the agenda items are appreciated by the Board of Directors and may be taken into consideration at this time or during that agenda item. All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof.
2. Review and approve minutes of prior meeting.
3. Developer's report.
4. Construction Manager Agent's report regarding Hunter Ranch/Landmark Phase 1 and Roark Branch Sanitary Sewer Line, including status of construction projects within the District.
5. Engineering matters, including authorize design, preparation of plans and specifications, approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award, approval of Pay Estimates, Change Orders, and Task Orders, acceptance of projects, issuance of notices to the City of Denton and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facility, if appropriate, for projects, including:

 - b. Hunter Ranch – 1C/1D Paving Improvements;
 - c. Hunter Ranch-1A, 1B, 1C, 1D Landscape Improvements;

 - e. Hunter Ranch-1A, 1B, 1C, 1D Hardscape Improvements;
 - f. Storm Drainage Facilities to serve Project Pilot;
 - g. Roark Branch Sanitary Sewer project, including approval of withdrawal request to escrow agent;
 - h. next phase of District facilities;
 - i. approve deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
 - j. other engineering matters.

11. Tax assessment and collection matters, including:
 - a. adopt Resolution Concerning Exemptions from Taxation; and
 - b. adopt Resolution Regarding Development Status for 2026 Tax Year.
12. Report from Triton Consulting Group regarding the District's website and authorize appropriate action.
