1. Hear from Public (public session limited to 15 minutes; each speaker limited to 3 minutes);
2. Hear Public Safety Reports (Police/Fire/EMS) and take action thereon;
3. Consider approving Minutes of February 10, 2026;
4. Hear Bookkeeper's Report, and take any action thereon, including:
 - (a) consider approving payment of bills; and
 - (b) consider approving investment report;
5. Consider accepting resignation of District Bookkeeper;
6. Review Bookkeeping proposals and consider engaging District Bookkeeper;
7. Hear Engineer's Report and take any action thereon, including:
 - (a) consider authorizing Engineer to proceed with the design of District facilities;
 - (b) consider approving plans and specifications of District facilities;
 - (c) consider authorizing Engineer to advertise for bids for District projects;
 - (d) consider authorizing construction contracts and related items; and
 - (e) consider approving report, pay estimates and change orders for construction projects in progress in the District;

 - (a) consider approving Order Canceling Directors' Election and Declaring Unopposed Candidates Elected to Office.

Government Code §551, the Board of Directors may convene in closed session in relation to any agenda item included in this Notice, with such closed session to be held at the date, hour, and place given in this Notice, concerning any and all subjects, for any and all purposes permitted by V.T.C.A. Government Code Chapter 551, including, but not limited to, private consultation with the District's Attorneys on any or all matters or subjects consider authorized by law, pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, security devices, economic development negotiations and/or gifts and donations.
