3. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills, and review of investments.
4. Review and adoption of District's Operating Budget for Fiscal Year Ending April 30, 2027.
5. Tax assessment and collections matters.
6. Consider matters regarding entering into a contract for delinquent tax collection legal services and adopt Resolution Regarding Approval of Legal Services Contract.
7. Annual Review of Resolution Adopting Prevailing Wage Rate Scale for Construction Products.
8. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. status of construction projects within the District;
  - b. authorizing/ratification and preparation of plans and specifications for water, sewer and road improvements;
  - c. approval/ratification of construction plans and specifications of District facilities;
  - d. authorize/ratify Engineer to advertise for bids for District projects;
  - e. award/recission of construction contract(s) and related items;
  - f. approval/ratification of pay application(s) and change order(s) for construction projects in the District;
  - g. approval/ratification of engineering task order(s);
  - h. consider acceptance of certificates of completion and authorize final acceptance of projects;
  - i. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility commitment letters;
  - j. notices of default or other matters related to noncompliance with construction contracts; and
  - k. allocation of costs for facilities shared with Tradition Municipal Utility District No. 2B of Denton County.
9. Developer's Report, including consent to assignment of receivables.
10. District website and communication matters.
