1. Hear from Public (public session limited to 15 minutes; each speaker limited to 3 minutes);
2. Hear Public Safety Reports (Police/Fire/EMS) and take action thereon;
3. Consider approving Minutes of March 10, 2026;
4. Hear Bookkeeper's Report, and take any action thereon, including:
 - (a) consider approving payment of bills;
 - (b) consider approving investment report and
 - (c) consider approving Depository Pledge Agreement with Central Bank;
5. Consider termination of District's Financial Advisor (R.W. Baird);
6. Review proposals and consider engaging District Financial Advisor;
7. Hear Engineer's Report and take any action thereon, including:
 - (a) consider authorizing Engineer to proceed with the design of District facilities;
 - (b) consider approving plans and specifications of District facilities;
 - (c) consider authorizing Engineer to advertise for bids for District projects;
 - (d) consider authorizing construction contracts and related items; and
 - (e) consider approving report, pay estimates and change orders for construction projects in progress in the District;

Government Code Chapter 551, including, but not limited to, private consultation with the District's Attorneys on any or all matters or subjects consider authorized by law, pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, security devices, economic development negotiations and/or gifts and donations.
