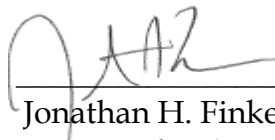

1. Determination of Quorum and Call to Order (RF).
2. Pledges of Allegiance (RF).
3. Public comment(s) – In accordance with the Open Meetings Act, Directors are prohibited from acting on or discussing any new items brought before them at this time. Citizens' comments will be limited to 3 minutes. Comments about any of the agenda items are appreciated by the Board of Directors and may be taken into consideration at this time or during that agenda item. All remarks and questions addressed to the Board shall be addressed to the Board as a whole and not to any individual member thereof (RF).
4. Discuss 2026 tax rate, set public hearing date, and authorize notice of public hearing regarding adoption of tax rate (JF).
